

RESOLUTION 2000- 172

WHEREAS the Special Drug and Alcohol Rehabilitation Fund has received fines and interest in excess of amount budgeted. Per F.S. 893.165(1) and 893.165(6), a designated program recipient can use fine revenues for alcohol and other drug abuse treatment or education programs. The Board has contracted with The Nassau County Mental Health, Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Council, Inc. to provide substance abuse services and is the designated recipient.

WHEREAS this revenue was not anticipated in the 1999/2000 budget year by the Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 23rd day of October, 2000 the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06 (2)(d) be adopted:
