

RESOLUTION 2000 - 183

A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS OR RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION FUNDING A TOP PRIORITY AND TO MOVE AHEAD WITH A STUDY OF THE A1A CORRIDOR.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware that the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Five Year Plan does not include funding for any improvements of the A1A corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has consistently expressed concerns to FDOT about the A1A corridor.



1. The Board strongly encourages the Florida Department of Transportation to include funding for improvements of A1A and to make improvements and/or acquisition of right-of-way for A1A a top priority.
