

RESOLUTION 2000 - 20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE LEASE FIFTEEN (15) ADDITIONAL ACRES TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, Nassau County has a community building and recreational ball fields adjacent to lands within the Cary State Forest in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is desirous of leasing an additional fifteen (15) acres for recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Department has accommodated the Board in the past; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is essential that the additional fifteen (15) acres be leased for recreational purposes.


