WHEREAS, the election of Commissioner Rudy Maloy would greatly benefit all Florida counties and their residents; and


WHEREAS, it is important to have a representative from the State of Florida on a national level through the National Association of Counties.

The Board hereby offers its supports to Leon County Commissioner Rudy Maloy in his campaign for the office of Second Vice President of the National Association of Counties.


