

RESOLUTION ~~2000~~-2001-15

WHEREAS the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund has been awarded a Federal Pass-Through Grant from the State of Florida in which 75% of the funding is derived from Federal funds. Revenues and expenditures relate to Nassau County drug eradication.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated in the 2000/01 budget year for the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 22nd day of January, 2001, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06 (2) (d) be adopted:




