

RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 61

A RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CERTIFYING THAT MONIES FROM THE EMS COUNTY GRANT AWARD WILL BE USED TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND THE COUNTY'S EXISTING PRE-HOSPITAL EMS SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is responsible for the provisions of pre-hospital Emergency Medical Service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has committed to maintaining and improving pre-hospital Emergency Medical Services to the citizens and residents of Nassau County, Florida, and that the grant monies will not be used to supplement existing County EMS Budget Allocations.


