ADOPTING LOCAL LHAP FOR  
FY2000 -2001, FY2001 - 2002, FY2002 - 2003

WHEREAS, the Florida Housing Finance Corporation and the Florida Statutes Chapter 420, Part 7 require an adopted Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) prior to receipt and distribution of the State Housing Initiatives Partnership funds; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County SHIP Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) for FY2000-01, FY2001-02 and FY2002-03 adopted by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners needs to be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee has recommended that a strategy be added; and

WHEREAS, the LHAP shall affect the distribution of SHIP funds available in each fiscal year and for each strategy; and



WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners wishes to amend the Nassau County SHIP Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) for FY2000 - 2001, FY2001 - 2002 and FY2002 - 2003 to include a rental unit development strategy as recommended by the Nassau County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners, in their meeting assembled on May 13, 2002, that the Nassau County Local Housing Assistance Plan for FY2000 - 2001, FY2001 - 2002 and FY2002 - 2003 be hereby amended as presented.




