WHEREAS, the needs of the world's children have increased over time, so has the need for companies to play a more active role in affecting positive change in their communities; and


WHEREAS, more than 29,000 McDonald's restaurants in 121 countries will participate in one day of charity for the world's children; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 26th day of August, 2002, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. Hereby proclaims November 20, 2002 as World Children's Day at McDonald's restaurants in Nassau County, Florida.


