

**RESOLUTION 02 - 163**

**WHEREAS** on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2002 the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes for the fiscal year from October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003 and

**WHEREAS**, on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2002 the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing to finalize the 2002/2003 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2002, hereby adopts the following millage rates individually for the fiscal year from October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2003:

TOTAL COUNTY WIDE MILLAGE	7.3821
MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT	.3224
REC & WATER CONSERVATION DIST. 1	<u>.0000</u>
TOTAL MILLAGE	7.7045

The Fiscal Year 2002/2003 County Wide operating millage rate, excluding special districts, is 7.3821 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 6.3714 mills by 15.86%.

The Fiscal Year 2002/2003 Municipal Service Taxing District operating millage rate is .3224 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of .2743 mills by 17.54%.


The Fiscal Year 2002/2003 Nassau County Recreation and Water Conservation and Control District 1 operating millage is 0 mills. There was no tax levied in Fiscal Year 2001/2002.

The Fiscal Year 2002/2003 Total County aggregate operating millage rate is 7.6151 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 6.5697 by 15.91%.


