

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE NEWLY FORMED NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, THE AMELIA ARTS CENTRE; TO SUPPORT THE NEED OF A CULTURAL ARTS CENTER IN FERNANDINA BEACH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there has been a longtime desire for a community arts center in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide a broad range of cultural offerings to Amelia Island, Fernandina Beach and Nassau County residents and visitors, and to excite interest in and enthusiasm for the arts in young people; and

WHEREAS, the Amelia Arts Centre will provide access to a wider variety of performing arts than currently exists in Nassau County through productions of new and exciting programs, live performances, and first-run events; and

WHEREAS, the Centre will offer educational programs that appeal to diverse audiences of all age groups and abilities including the elderly, young people, and the physically disadvantaged as well as the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Centre will provide programs to attract interest in the arts in young people and will provide a stage for young, new talent to master their craft. The Centre will advance in development of local artists.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 26th day of July, 2004 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby support the mission and the project of the Amelia Arts Centre, the newly formed non-profit organization.
2. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, does hereby support the need for a cultural arts center to be located in Fernandina Beach.


