WHEREAS, Vickie Samus, as a County Commissioner, directly stated her position and has been a vigorous


advocate for the issues that she thought were best for the majority of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8th day of December 2004, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:


