

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-184

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE NASSAU COUNTY
LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY.**

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Local Mitigation Strategy Task Force was created in August 1998, with the responsibility of developing a Local Mitigation Strategy; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County initially adopted the Local Mitigation Strategy on August 13, 2001; and

WHEREAS, with the adoption of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, and the adoption of 44 CFR parts 201 and 206, the Federal Emergency Management Agency added requirements that necessitated revision and re-adoption of the document throughout the county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2002-184 on October 21, 2002 requesting funding to bring the Local Mitigation Strategy into compliance with the new regulations; and


WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Community Affairs provided funding to the Northeast Florida Regional Council to facilitate the revision process with Nassau County and complete the new requirements for the Local Mitigation Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy Task Force accepted the revised Strategy on June 15, 2004 and has recommended it for acceptance by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of December 2004, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:


1. That the revised Nassau County Local Mitigation Strategy is endorsed as the guiding plan to mitigate dangers and costs associated with natural and man-made disasters, and to provide a priority for recovery in the event of hazardous events occurring in the county and its municipalities.
2. That the Local Mitigation Strategy shall be reviewed and modified as described in the Strategy.
3. The Local Mitigation Strategy Task Force shall maintain all state and/or federal requirements of the Local Mitigation Strategy, maintain a current list of potential local projects, and review the Local Mitigation Strategy with the Board of County Commissioners at least annually as requested by the Board of County Commissioners.


