

RESOLUTION 2004 -46A

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AMEND THEIR ENGINEERING PLANS FOR SR 200/A1A.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has, in a presentation in Nassau County, indicated that SR 200/A1A would be six-laned from I-95 to CR 107 and tapering to four-lanes beyond CR 107 at the curve; and

WHEREAS, the six-lanes should extend from I-95 to Marsh Lakes and not stop at CR 107.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of April, 2004, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby requests that the Florida Department of Transportation extend the six-laning of SR 200/A1A from I-95 to the Marsh Lakes subdivision instead of to CR 107.

3. The Board hereby requests that Secretary Schroder advise the Board of County Commissioners as to this

request.
