

RESOLUTION 2004 - 87

b. Coastline security and vessels in the amount of \$250,000.00.


c. Preliminary engineering for A1A widening in the amount of \$2,050,000.00.

d. SCRAP funding to resurface CR 121 in the amount of \$4,000,000.00.


e. FRDAP funds for building and improvements at Goffinsville Park.
