

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 147

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2006 the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held a public hearing on the tentative budget and the proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, for the fiscal year from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007.

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2006 the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held a public meeting to finalize the 2006-2007 Budget to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in Regular Session duly assembled on the 25th day of September, 2006, hereby adopts the following millage rates individually for the fiscal year from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007:

The Fiscal Year 2006-2007 County Wide operating millage rate, excluding special districts is 6.1821 mills, which is

greater than the rolled back rate of 5.4852 mills by 12.71 percent.


The Fiscal Year 2006/2007 Municipal Service Taxing Unit operating millage rate is 1.8224 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 1.5491 mills by 17.64 percent.

The Fiscal Year 2006/2007 Nassau County Recreation and Water Conservation and Control District 1 operating millage is 0 mills. There was no tax levied in Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

The Fiscal Year 2006/2007 Total County Aggregate operating millage rate is 7.5155 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 6.6109 mills by 13.68 percent.




