

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-163

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED  
FUNDING OF THE ST. JOHNS RIVER FERRY

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Ferry is an important link in  
State Road A1A; and

WHEREAS, discontinuing the St. Johns River Ferry service  
would discourage many motorists who would use alternate routes  
instead of A1A from Nassau County, through Mayport to Neptune  
Beach, Jacksonville Beach, Ponte Vedra and St. Augustine since  
the continuity of scenic A1A would be broken; and

WHEREAS, discontinuing the St. Johns River Ferry service  
would be detrimental to businesses that benefit from travelers  
who use scenic State Road A1A to Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, State Road A1A uses the St. Johns River Ferry to  
continue traffic flow and closing the ferry would result in  
increased congestion and increased travel for the citizens of  
Nassau County to travel to the Jacksonville Beach area; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Ferry will become an  
increasingly important transportation option as the population  
continues to grow on both sides of the river as well as the  
growing Navy base; and

WHEREAS, taking the St. Johns River Ferry is an experience  
and is part of our history that celebrates the St. Johns River.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County  
Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of November  
2006 that:


1. The Board of County Commissioners supports continuation of the St. Johns River Ferry service.


