WHEREAS, Clyde Sikes has announced his retirement on March 29, 2007; and


WHEREAS, Clyde Sikes will be deeply missed by those who have had the honor to work with him.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 26th day of March, 2007, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:


1. The Board publicly commends Clyde Sikes for his thirty-five (35) years of outstanding dedicated service to the citizens of Nassau County.
2. The Board acknowledges Clyde Sikes for his outstanding service to the Board of County Commissioners as well as to those who have had the privilege to work with him.


3. The Board thanks Clyde Sikes for all that he has done to make this a great County.


