

RESOLUTION NO. 2008- 142

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA ENCOURAGING THE OFFICE OF THE STATE ATTORNEY, THE NASSAU COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL TO AGGRESSIVELY ENFORCE THE ANTI-GAMBLING LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA**

**WHEREAS**, it is well established and documented that gambling has an adverse financial impact upon the least fortunate and most financially vulnerable members of our society; and

**WHEREAS**, gambling contributes to social ills such as homelessness, poverty, indebtedness, and financial distress; and

**WHEREAS**, such activities are inconsistent with the established community standards of conduct of Nassau County, Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** this 13th day of August 2008 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:



The Board does hereby respectfully request that the State of Florida and local law enforcement, including the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit and the United States Attorney for the North District of Florida do aggressively act using all resources at their disposal to enforce all laws which prohibit unlawful gambling activities.


