

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-145**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA DUE TO TROPICAL STORM FAY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2008-143 on August 19, 2008 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to Tropical Storm Fay; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and

**WHEREAS**, the seven day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 25th day of August 2008 as follows:




