

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-164

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE NASSAU COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION TO SPONSOR A LOCAL BILL ESTABLISHING PILOT PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSES OF ENCOURAGING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PRIVATE SECTION JOB CREATION

WHEREAS, the national unemployment rate for October 2010 is 9.6 percent; and

WHEREAS, the unemployment rate for October for the State of Florida is 11.9 percent; and

WHEREAS, the unemployment rate for October for Nassau County is 10.4 percent; and

WHEREAS, over 50 percent of Nassau County citizens travel outside the county on a daily basis for employment; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County has seen an increase of over 180 percent in food stamp applications; and


WHEREAS, the State of Florida offers numerous individual economic development or job creation incentives.
