**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

**WHEREAS**, Live Oak Baptist Church began as a meeting place in a one room log cabin in 1845; and

**WHEREAS**, from humble beginnings, the Live Oak Baptist Church has grown to its current facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Live Oak Baptist Church has served the citizenry of Nassau County for 165 years; and

**WHEREAS**, in August of 1999 Pastor Stephen Wolgamott was called to serve as pastor and is currently the longest continually serving pastor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners commends Live Oak Baptist Church and Pastor Wolgamott and the entire congregation for their contributions toward the betterment of the citizens of Nassau County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, this 10th day of May, 2010, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. Congratulates and recognizes Live Oak Baptist Church on their 165<sup>th</sup> anniversary.


2. Extends, on behalf of the citizens of Nassau County, their appreciation for all that Pastor Wolgamott and the congregation do for the community.


