2. The Board acknowledges James L. Rhoden for his outstanding service to the Board of County Commissioners, as well as those who had the privilege to work with him.


3. The Board, on behalf of all the citizens of Nassau County, extends their sincere appreciation to James L. Rhoden for all he has done to make this a great County.




