

RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 81

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF JUNE 4-8, 2012 AS CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' APPRECIATION WEEK IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers provide for safety, health, and welfare of citizens in this community through the enforcement of building, zoning, housing, animal control, fire safety, environmental and other codes and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers are often not credited for the jobs that they do in saving lives and improving neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, every day, assisted by support and program staff, they attempt to provide quality customer service to the public for the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, too many times their efforts go unnoticed, even after code compliance has been accomplished due to their efforts and expertise; and

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers are dedicated, well trained, and highly responsible individuals who take their jobs seriously and are proud of their department and the local government within which they serve; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Association of Code Enforcement (F.A.C.E.) has declared the first week of June be set aside by local government to honor and recognize their Code Enforcement Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 16th day of May, 2012, that:

1. The week of June 4-8, 2012 be proclaimed as Code Enforcement Officers' Appreciation Week, in accordance with the statewide observance of the same; and
2. Encourage citizens of Nassau County to join the Board in expressing appreciation for their dedication and outstanding service provided by the individuals who serve as our Code Enforcement Officers.


