NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida this 17th day of December 2014, as follows:


1. The Board publicly thanks and commends Stephen Mark Johnson for fourteen (14) plus years of outstanding service dedicated to the citizens of Nassau County.

sincere appreciation to Stephen Mark Johnson for all he has done to make this a great County.




