

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-136

A RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCLAIMING NOVEMBER 15, 2015 AS "NATIONAL RECYCLE DAY" IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, each year, Americans generate about 240 million tons of solid waste, much of which ends up in a landfill; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the waste that is generated can be recycled; and

WHEREAS, it is important that we preserve our natural heritage by serving as good stewards of our land; and

WHEREAS, recycling helps to serve this important function by conserving our natural resources and their reuse where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, recycling reduces our country's energy consumption, decreases our greenhouse gas emissions, and conserves our natural resources; and

WHEREAS, citizens are encouraged to save resources by practicing the 3 R's – Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle; and

2. The Board encourages all citizens to do their part to build a more prosperous and sustainable future.

3. The Board hereby proclaims November 15, 2015 as "National Recycle Day" in Nassau County, Florida.
