

RESOLUTION 2017- 36

A RESOLUTION WHICH ESTABLISHES A POLICY REGARDING MEMBERSHIP ON BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPOINTED COMMITTEES AND BOARDS.


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2005-92 and Resolution No. 2009-15 which established policies regarding citizen membership on committees and boards appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, based on Attorney General's opinions, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary to adopt this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 15th day of March, 2017 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution No. 2017-36 setting policies for appointments to Boards and Committees is hereby adopted:

1. No individual citizen may simultaneously serve, as a Board appointee, on more than one board created by the Board of County Commissioners at the same point in time, if a position on an appointed Board is an office pursuant to State Administrative or Court interpretation.
2. An individual may simultaneously serve, as a Board Appointee, on more than one committee created by the Board of County Commissioners at the same point in time.
3. Any appointee now serving simultaneously on more than one board, if the position is an office, shall be asked to choose the board that they desire to remain on, and said choice shall be made within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Resolution. The Board of County Commissioners shall fill any vacancy created.
4. This policy shall become effective upon its execution by the Chairman.


