WHEREAS, every business, industry, school, and citizen can make a difference when it comes to conserving water; and


WHEREAS, every business, industry, school, and citizen can help by saving water and thus promote a healthy economy and community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 10th day of April, 2017, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:


1. April 2017 is hereby declared as Water Conservation Month in Nassau County, Florida.


