WHEREAS, Ormond Ford has announced his retirement effective January 3, 2020; and


WHEREAS, Ormond Ford will be greatly missed by those who had the privilege of working with him, as well as the citizens of Nassau County.

Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:


1. The Board publicly commends Ormond Ford for his outstanding service and dedication to Nassau County.
